



**IN VIRGINIA,** feeder cattle mostly 1.00 to 3.00 lower. Slaughter cows steady to 3.00 lower. Slaughter bulls mostly 2.00 to 4.00 lower. Wheat .21 higher, new crop .13 higher. Corn mostly .06 to .16 higher. Soybeans mostly .27 to .30 higher. Barley mostly steady. Milo .06 to .28 higher.

**IN THE NATION,** feeder cattle uneven, ranging 2.00 lower to 2.00 higher; calves unevenly steady. Slaughter cattle trade very light in all feeding regions and no trend is available. Slaughter cows and bulls mostly 1.00 to 5.00 lower. Slaughter lambs steady to 10.00 higher except San Angelo, TX sharply lower. Feeder lambs steady to 9.00 higher. Hogs carcass basis .52 higher. Wheat .05 to .46 higher. Corn .04 to .21 higher. Soybeans .22 to .38 higher. Cotton .0024 lower per pound in the Southeast.
