



IN VIRGINIA, feeder cattle mostly 3.00 to 10.00 higher. Slaughter cows uneven, ranging 3.00 lower to 3.00 higher. Slaughter bulls unevenly steady. Wheat .10 lower, new crop mostly .10 lower. Corn mostly steady to .04 higher, new crop mostly .03 higher. Soybeans mostly .27 higher, new crop .24 higher. Milo uneven, .01 lower to .04 higher, new crop .03 higher.

IN THE NATION, feeder cattle uneven, steady to 8.00 lower early in the week and 2.00 to 8.00 higher late in the week. Slaughter cattle mostly inactive with dressed basis sales in Nebraska 3.00 higher at 195.00. Slaughter cows and bulls mostly steady to 2.00 lower with the exception of Colorado trading 2.00 to 3.00 higher. Slaughter lambs mostly steady. Feeder lambs not well tested. Hogs carcass basis .09 lower. Wheat mostly .01 to .07 lower. Corn mostly .02 to .08 higher. Soybeans mostly .23 higher. Cotton .0174 higher per pound in the Southeast.

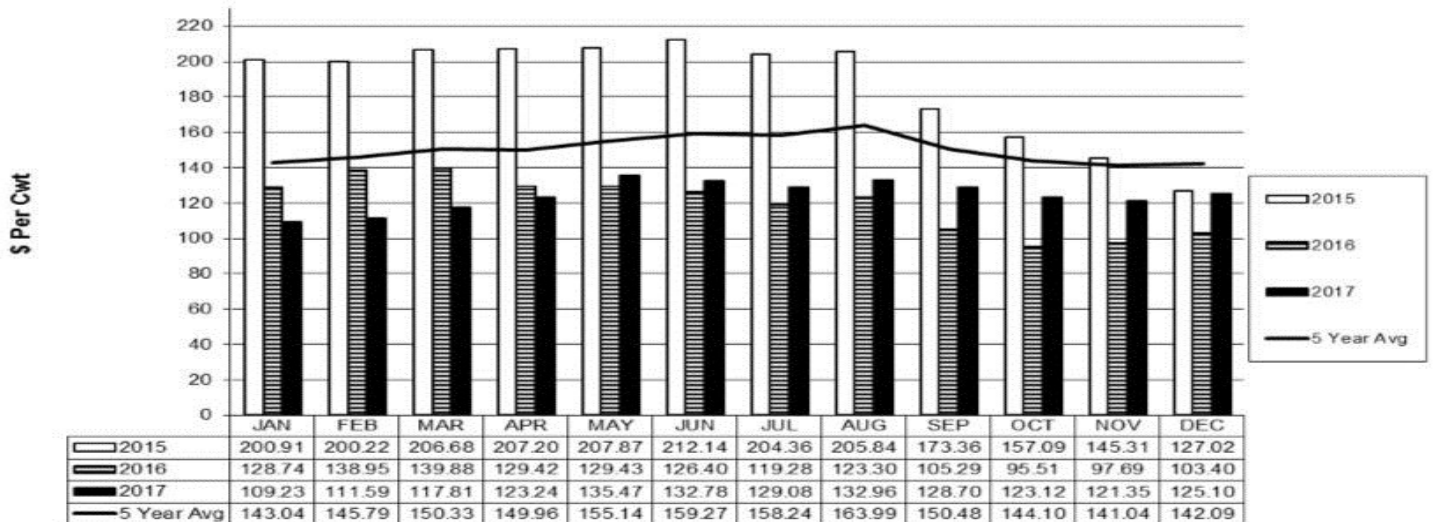
