U.S. Small Business Administration



Our professionals conduct preliminary research, identify and vet potential targets, set your meetings, and arrange the logistics with your active input. The only costs not covered are translation and ground transportation to meetings.

Each company will also be able to be reimbursed 75% of eligible travel expenses up to \$2,500. Eligible travel expenses include: airfare (must meet the Fly America Act) and hotel room fee.

To qualify, companies should:

- ⇒ Be new to export OR new to the China market
- ⇒ Meet the requirements of SBA's definition of an "Eligible Small Business Concern" as follows:

- Been in business for a year
- Be profitable
- Have operations in the U.S.
