MINI BULK CONTAINER RECYCLING SURVEY FORM

The new EPA Pesticide Container and Containment Rule that went into effect in August of 2011 has rendered many refillable pesticide mini-bulk containers unusable. Any non-compliant tanks need to have been retrofitted or taken out of service and this action may result in increasing stockpiles of old or damaged mini-bulk tanks in warehouses, mixing yards, storage facilities and farms.
