IN THE NATION, feeder cattle uneven, mostly steady early in the week, steady to 2.00 lower after grain prices surged at midweek. The cattle market is saturated with calves that sold 1.00-3.00 lower, many locations as much as 5.00 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls steady to 2.00 lower. Early-weaned pigs and all feeder pigs mostly steady. Barrows and gilts 3.48-5.20 higher, Sioux Falls 5.50 higher. Slaughter lambs mostly steady to 3.00 lower. Slaughter ewes steady to 4.00 lower. Feeder lambs steady to 5.00 lower. Wheat mostly .06-.14 higher. Corn .04-.10 higher, KC white corn .29-.32 higher. Sorghum .14 higher. Soybeans .04-.14 higher. Cotton .0145 lower at .4538.
