



IN VIRGINIA, state graded feeder cattle 2.00 to 9.00 lower. Feeder cattle at regular auction sales steady to 6.00 higher. Slaughter cows mostly steady. Slaughter bulls uneven, mostly 1.00 lower to 3.00 higher. Wheat .20 to .24 higher, new crop .24 higher. Corn .17 to .71 higher, new crop .80 higher. Soybeans mostly .42 to .68 higher, new crop .90 higher.

IN THE NATION, feeder cattle mostly 1.00 to 4.00 lower with the exception of steers in the North Central region suitable for grass being 1.00 to 3.00 higher. Slaughter cattle live basis mostly steady to 1.00 lower at 117.00 to 120.00; dressed basis sales mostly 2.00 lower at 187.00 to 192.00. Slaughter cows uneven, mostly 4.00 lower to 2.00 higher. Slaughter bulls uneven, mostly 3.00 lower to 3.00 higher. Slaughter lambs mostly steady to 30.00 lower with the exception of San Angelo, TX 10.00 to 15.00 higher. Feeder lambs not well tested. Hogs carcass basis 1.21 higher. Wheat mostly .13 to .24 higher. Corn mostly .50 to .73 higher. Soybeans mostly .57 to .68 higher. Cotton .0158 higher per pound in the Southeast.
