IN VIRGINIA, state graded feeder cattle mostly steady to 6.00 higher. Feeder cattle at regular auction sales mostly 14.00 to 21.00 lower. Slaughter cows uneven, ranging 8.00 lower to 5.00 higher. Wheat .20 lower, new crop mostly .07 to .17 lower. Corn mostly .05 lower, new crop .09 lower. Sovbeans mostly .16 higher, new crop .03 higher.

IN THE NATION, feeder cattle mostly 1.00 to 10.00 higher. Slaughter cattle live basis mostly 4.00 to 5.00 higher at 208.00 to 219.00; dressed basis sales mostly 4.00 to 5.00 higher at 335.00 to 345.00. Slaughter cows mostly steady to 4.00 higher. Slaughter bulls mostly steady to 4.00 higher. Slaughter lambs unevenly steady at New Holland, PA. Slaughter ewes steady to weak at New Holland, PA. Feeder lambs not tested. Hogs carcass basis 8.04 higher. Wheat mostly .14 to .20 lower. Corn mostly .05 to .09 lower. Soybeans mostly .16 to .21 higher. Cotton .0142 higher per pound in the Southeast.

March Commercial Red Meat Production Up from 2024

Commercial red meat production for the United States totaled 4.42 billion pounds in March, up 1 percent from the 4.38 billion up slightly from the previous year. Hog slaughpounds produced in March 2024.

Beef production, at 2.15 billion pounds, was 2 percent above the previous year. Cattle slaughter totaled 2.48 million head, down 1 weight was up 34 pounds from the previous year, at 1,426 pounds.

Veal production totaled 2.1 million pounds, 42 percent below March a year ago. Calf slaughter totaled 10,900 head, down 43 percent from March 2024. The average live weight was up 5

pounds from last year, at 327 pounds.

Pork production totaled 2.25 billion pounds, ter totaled 10.4 million head, down slightly from March 2024. The average live weight was up 2 pounds from the previous year, at 291 pounds.

Lamb and mutton production, at 12.8 percent from March 2024. The average live million pounds, was up 4 percent from March 2024. Sheep slaughter totaled 199,200 head, slightly below last year. The average live weight was 127 pounds, up 5 pounds from March a year ago.
